BRIAN ON FILM

Brian Wilbur has recently been exploring the wonderful world of cinema and film scoring.



BWG recently scored his first full film score, **Reunion** by filmmaker **Andy Bely**. The story is about a group of friends who gather at a farm to celebrate the 10th anniversary of their high school graduation. Their ultra-liberal ideals capsize when they discover one of them has turned to the dark side: yes, he's become a right-wing corporate lawyer! BWG also produced the recording with his studio and sample from Vienna Symphonic Library.

In writing for Reunion, BWG applied the skills learned at the prestigious New York University/ASCAP Film Scoring Workshop in memory of Buddy Baker

Brian's experience at the workshop included scoring a dream sequence for the network TV show **Smallville** and conducting a 20-piece orchestra to click track synchronization for the sequence.

BRIAN IN THE MAYOR'S OFFICE -RECEIVES DC ARTS GRANT -



That would be Washington D.C. Mayor Anthony A. Williams' office, where Brian received a very prestigious individual DC Arts Grant artist fellowship from the D.C. Commission on the Arts and Humanities, an Agency funded in part by the National Endowment for the Arts.

The funding awards, which total \$4.5 million to DC artists and arts organizations, support public performances, arts in education and other cultural enrichment activities. In

this case, Brian is using it to fund part of his first commercial CD. **Fun fact:** Arts and culture are the second leading industry for the city behind tourism, generating an impressive \$1.4 billion for the District's economy each year.

COMMISSION FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S COLLA VOCE

Brian has just finished **How I Met Sam**, a commission for **Colla Voce** (http://www.colla-voce.org), a men's ensemble in San Francisco, founded in February 2004.



Lyrics are by **James Skofield**, who is known for Seattle Mens' Chorus commission of A Night Passage and the Houston's Grand Opera's commission of A Dracula Diary, both with composer Robert Moran. **How I Met Sam** will be performed June 11th and July 9th in San Francisco, and August 1st at the Out Games in Montreal.
